

LIONS SCHOLARSHIP

The Muskegon Northside Lions Club will offer a graduating senior who excells in the area of service a \$1000 scholarship to further their education. The money for this fund is raised each year by the club. The Lions are involved with many areas of service in the community, including food trucks, building handicap ramps, placing the American flags on special days, visual and hearing needs and the Causeway improvements and lighting during the holidays to name a few.

One-half of the scholarship money will be given for the first term and then the second half will be given for the second term. When the student is ready to pay fees in the fall, all they need to do is contact the Scholarship Committee of the Muskegon Northside Lions Club. A check for the student, made out to the college, will be sent directly to the college. The phone number that needs to be called, will be provided with the Scholarship Award Letter that will be presented at the scholarship award ceremony at the high school. This scholarship must be used during the next school year following the presentation of the scholarship.

Some of the criteria that this scholarship will be based on is service, need, GPA/ACT, activities, character, and possible others. The weight of these will be determined by the Lions.

It should be completed and returned to the high school counseling office before the April 15th deadline.

This application must be approved by the Principal or Counselor and a Senior Class Advisor.

Include at least two letters of reference from someone other than a relative with this application. Also include a copy of your high school transcript with ACT/SAT scores.
