Career Scholarship

*APPLICATION DEADLINE: MAY 1

Eligibility

High school seniors are eligible to apply for Baker College Career Scholarships. Winners will be selected by a Scholarship Awards Committee on the basis of academic achievement. The \$6,400 scholarships are applied toward each winner's tuition at the rate of up to \$400 per quarter (\$400 full-time, \$300 %-time, and \$200 part-time). Scholarship may be used for a total of 16 quarters. Financial need is not a criterion for this award. Application deadline is May 1.

Requirements and Guidelines

To receive the scholarship, the student must attend at least half-time (6 credit hours per quarter) and must enter during either the summer or fall quarter following graduation from high school. Students must have a 3.0 or higher G.P.A. (on a 4.0 scale) or higher at the end of their junior year or after the first semester senior year. In order to be awarded this scholarship students must test into one or fewer Developmental Education Courses (determined through Baker College Compass Assessment). Applying for financial aid (by May 1) in addition to this scholarship is encouraged. Should a student receive other aid, it will be applied first. Any excess scholarship, after direct costs, is returned to the scholarship fund. This scholarship is renewable for a total of 16 quarters if the student maintains a 2.5 G.P.A. at Baker, monitored at the end of each academic year. This scholarship cannot be used in combination with other Baker College scholarship funds. Enrollment must be continuous with the exception of summer quarter. The application deadline is May 1.

*Students must meet minimum Baker College entrance requirements in order to use this scholarship.

How to Apply

High school seniors with a 3.0 G.P.A. or higher (on a 4.0 scale) through junior year or first semester senior year (whichever is higher) may apply. Ask your High School Counselor to attach a transcript and send it to the Baker College location you plan to attend. In the event of a tie, scholarships will be awarded on a first received, first awarded basis.


